Here at Ormiston NEW Academy, all staff are committed to improving reading across all curriculum areas and also through promoting reading for pleasure.

All of our students:

- At KS3—receive a complimentary book to read for pleasure through 'Book Buzz'
- At KS3 FUR sessions in class to read for pleasure
- Read one non-fiction article per week with their tutor
- Have excellent teaching modelled to them by their teachers
- Are taught an English curriculum which allows for whole texts, extracts, short stories, non-fiction and poetry study across every year
- Receive reading across all subjects, as planned by each department, and covers online materials, autobiographies, biographies, research, articles, blogs and scripts
- Sit two reading diagnostic tests per year
- Have access to a fully stocked library as well as regular library sessions
- Can use the library before and after school and during lunchtimes
- Can engage in Reading Around the World enrichment which looks at texts from other cultures
- Have access to the by-weekly school reading podcast
- Can receive prizes for reading





Additional support is offered through:

- Weekly in-class tuition from a fully qualified teacher of English
- Adapted reading booklets to use during English lessons
- In class access to graphic novels
- Pearson Accessible Texts
- EAL students have a designated specialist for small group language access

Our SEND students are offered:

- Ruth Miskin's Fresh Start
- Explicit phonics teaching
- Comprehension based interventions
- Pre-teaching and post-teaching of vocabulary with a Teaching Assistant
- Access to a specialist teacher
- Additional DEAR in class
