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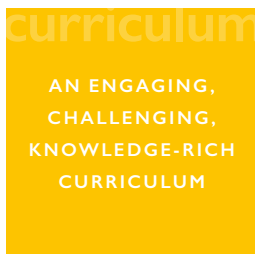
Welcome to Ormiston NEW Academy, where our values of **pride**, **endeavour** and **together** guide our journey towards excellence.

Led by a passionate pastoral team, we are dedicated to unlocking the full potential of every student, ensuring they not only succeed but flourish both personally and academically.

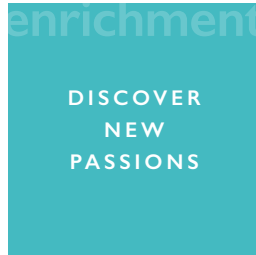
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Football academy
