Core knowledge: • To recognise Spanish word forms, key letters and sounds • To be able to greet someone in Spanish, and introduce yourself • To be able to count to 20, and recognise larger numbers • Say how old you are and when your birthday is • To be able to say where you live, where you used to live and say your nationality • To be able to say who is in your family • To be able to say what pets you have and describe their colour

Key questions:

Grammar: • formation of numbers • phonics - pronunciation (especially II, ñ, y & vowel sounds) • exposure to present tense verb forms • adjective agreement - singular m/f • ser & tener – present tense • hay / no hay • simple connectives - y, pero, también, • exposure to regular verb forms – present and imperfect
