At Ormiston NEW Academy, our school uniform is one of the key ways that students display our academy values including pride and togetherness. Time taken to rectify uniform and equipment infringements takes time away from this. As we approach the warmer weather, we appreciate that it may become uncomfortable for your child to wear their school uniform. Therefore, to support this, we have made the decision that students can either wear their full academy uniform or their full academy PE kit from **Friday 9**th **May 2025.**

Main uniform:

- Ormiston NEW Academy blazer
- Academy tie
- White shirt (top button must be fastened, and shirt tucked in)
- Black trousers which must be full length, plain and of a smart style (leggings or jogging bottoms are <u>not</u> permitted)
- Black polishable shoes (trainers are **not** permitted with main uniform)

PE Kit:

- Academy PE top (non-academy PE tops are <u>not</u> permitted)
- Plain black jogging bottoms (no large/obvious brands/logos)
- Plain black shorts (cycling shorts are **not** permitted)
- White/Black socks
- Trainers

Your child will have the option to wear full academy uniform or full academy PE kit throughout the remainder of the Summer term. The academy will continue to maintain high standards of uniform throughout the remainder of the year. If your child attends in incorrect uniform you will be contacted and uniform will have to be rectified immediately.
